and


WHEREAS, a lack of dependable road equipment makes it difficult for the Village to provide reasonable and responsive service throughout the Village; and



I am writing this letter to express the Village of Wagon Mound's desire to apply for the NMDOT 2025 Annual Hardship Program administered by the New Mexico State Highway and Transportation Department. This program allows public entities experiencing financial hardship to participate.

We believe the Village of Wagon Mound qualifies for this program due to our limited tax base which restricts accrual of funds to operate the Village. Our budgeted revenues to purchase vehicles and equipment necessary to provide services throughout the Village is nominal relative to cost. Due to this financial hardship, the Village is requesting approval of \$25,000.00 via the Annual Hardship Program to purchase surplus vehicles and/or equipment at the Annual Hardship Sale.
