WHEREAS, The Village of Wagon Mound, New Mexico is a municipal corporation, and acting by its Village Council, is in support of seeking funding assistance, in full or in part, for the planning, design, drainage improvements, pavement rehabilitation/improvements, reconstruction, construction management and miscellaneous of Caliche Street from Railroad Avenue to Catron Avenue and;

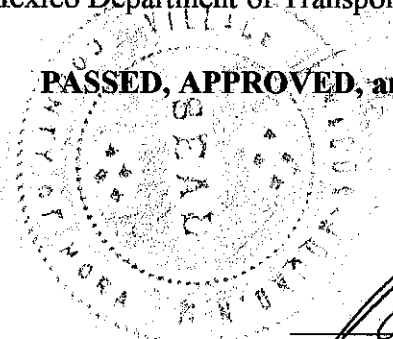
WHEREAS, The Village intends to request a waiver to the matching fund requirement, and;





Resolved, the Village of Wagon Mound will continue as an established incorporated community and will continue to provide a most satisfying quality of life and continue to be a most excellent community to live in.


Now Therefore, the honorable Mayor and Town Council of Wagon Mound declare 2018 as The Centennial Year and Year-Long Centennial Celebration
