### **Resolution No. 2017-05**

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF WAGON MOUND, NEW MEXICO, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A NEW MEXICO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION/LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE VILLAGE OF WAGON MOUND'S CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE VILLAGE OF WAGON MOUND'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the need exists within the Village of Wagon Mound for neighborhood improvement projects in several low and moderate income neighborhoods, and the Village of Wagon Mound desires to apply to the Housing and Urban Development's Community Development Block Grant Program to obtain funding for neighborhood improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, the Village has held 4 public hearings for public input and comment on February 15, 2017 at 9am, 2:30am and March 13, 2017 at 10am, 2:30pm during the 2017 application process; and


WHEREAS, the Village Council finds that there is a significant need to undertake the Water Distribution System Improvements – Phase I project to provide adequate services to the community; and


WHEREAS, the Village Council determines that the Water Distribution System Improvements – Phase I project meets the requirements of the Community Development Block Grant Program.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF WAGON MOUND, NEW MEXICO, that


1. The Village of Wagon Mound is hereby authorized to prepare and submit a Community Development Block Grant application to the New Mexico Department of Finance and Administration/Local Government Division for the Water Distribution System Improvements – Phase I project;
2. That the Village Council directs and designates the Mayor as the Village of Wagon Mound 's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the Village of Wagon Mound 's participation in the New Mexico Community Development Block Grant Program.
3. The Village of Wagon Mound officials and staff are directed to do any and all acts necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.
4. That the full application amount be for \$500,000 of grant funds and Phased be for \$450,000 for the Water Distribution System Improvements – Phase I project;
5. That it further be stated that the Village of Wagon Mound is committing 5% of either the full or phased project from its Utility Fund.



**WHEREAS**, people must not be denied housing because of race, color, religion, sex, gender, national origin, handicap or familial status; and





**WHEREAS**, we must, as individuals, assure equal access to housing for all in our communities; and
