Resolution No. 2016-08

PARTICIPATION IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT ROAD FUND PROGRAM NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the Village of Wagon Mound and the New Mexico Department of Transportation shall enter into a Cooperative Agreement;

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be \$40,000 to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:

- a. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$30,000

and

- b. The Village of Wagon Mound's proportional matching share shall be 25% or \$10,000.

TOTAL PROJECT COST IS \$40,000.

The Village of Wagon Mound shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of \$40,000.

Now therefore, be it resolved that the Village of Wagon Mound determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

- a. That the project for this Cooperative Agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.
- b. The agreement terminates on December 31, 2017 and the Village of Wagon Mound incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements, and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.
- c. The Village of Wagon Mound shall enter into Cooperative Agreement Project Number SP-4-17(970), CN L400284, with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for LGRF Project Fiscal Year 2016-2017 for the plan, design, construction management, construction, reconstruction, pavement rehab, drainage improvements and miscellaneous construction of various local streets (Catron Avenue between NMSR 120 and rodeo grounds entrance, Caliche Road between NMSR 271 and Railroad Avenue, Roybal Street from Railroad Avenue to Catron and Calhoun from Railroad Avenue to Catron) within the control of the Village of Wagon Mound in Mora County, New Mexico.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF WAGON MOUND, NEW MEXICO to participate in Local Government Road Fund Program with New Mexico Department of Transportation.
